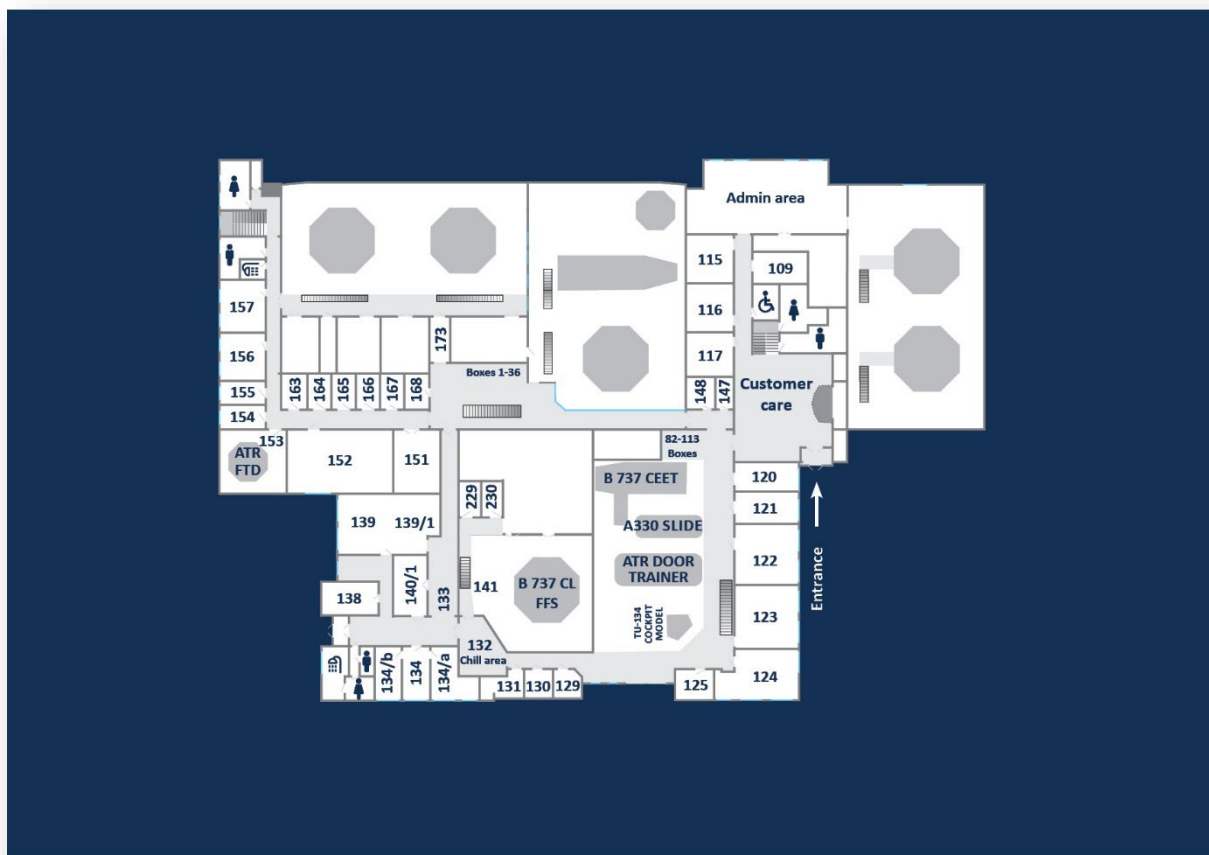

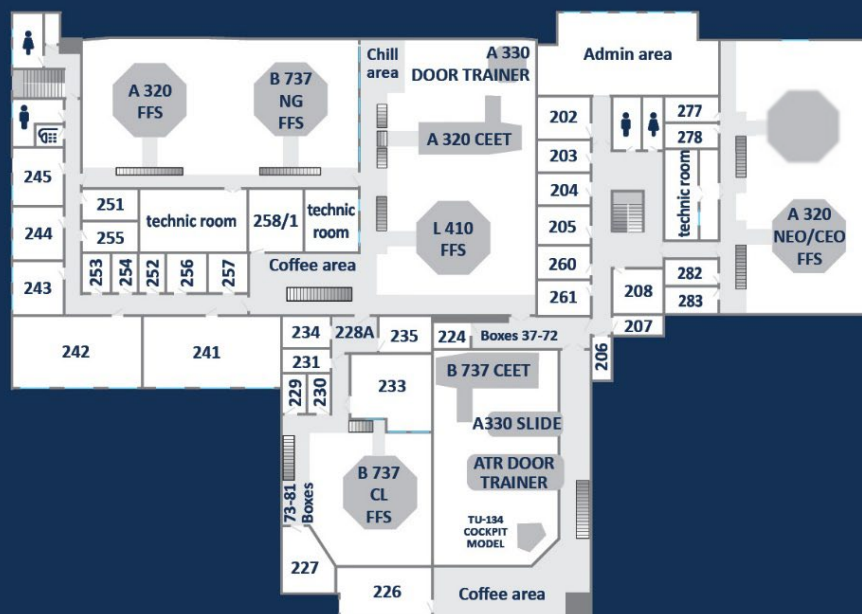

ID Badges

ID badge must be always worn. It will be provided to you at the entrance Gate No. 1 / “Vrátnice 1”/ and it must be returned daily at the same place at the end of your training.

Reception

Our Training Facilities are open 24/7, except January 1st and December 24th.

Our main reception operates from Mon to Fri from 6:30 a.m. to 18:30 p.m., Sat to Sun + public holidays from 8:30 a.m. to 16:30 p.m.

Training Schedule

Our Training Scheduling Coordinators will do their best to make your schedule as convenient as possible. Any changes to your schedule will be offered by the Customer Care Coordinators.

Information

Simulators and class rosters can be found on the LCD information screen in the reception area.

Photocopies/Faxes

Printing, copying, and scanning equipment is available at the reception desk. Please ask our Customer Care Coordinators for assistance if you need to copy or scan your documents. Payment must be done in advance.

Internet

Wi-Fi service is available in all areas of the CATC building.

Smoking

There is a strict no-smoking policy throughout the CATC building. Smoking is only allowed in the designated area in front of the building.

Coffee Break Area

Coffee break facilities are located on the second floor. Our vending and tea/coffee machines are available 24 hours a day to provide our guests with drinks and refreshments/snacks. All vending machines accept Czech crown coins, or you may use your contactless payment card.

Restaurant

There are 2 restaurants near the CATC building directly on K Letišti Street. Both restaurants are within a 10-minute walk from the main gate 1.

FBA restaurant is open from 7:00 a.m. - 15:00 p.m. Monday to Friday /Closed: Saturday to Sunday/. Lunch in this restaurant costs about 100 - 180CZK and you can pay in cash or by card. It is also a suitable place to relax and enjoy a drink after a long day at the training centre:

Parking

Parking is available in front of the CATC building. It is free of charge for our students and visitors.

Field Trip

If a part of your training takes place in SRA zone, be aware that:

ID badges must be worn and clearly visible.

HOW TO REACH US

Václav Havel Airport Prague and our training centre, located 17 kilometres from the centre of Prague, are easily accessible by bus, taxi, or shuttle, or you can use public transport from Václav Havel Airport Prague or from the metro station called Nádraží Veleslavín.

The bus journey from the airport to the Czech Aviation Training Centre takes 8 minutes. You can reach our training centre by buses number 100, 119 or 191 /the stop is called "K Letišti"/. Bus tickets are available at the public transport counters in the arrival halls of both terminals /from 7:00 to 22:00/.

There are bus ticket machines at bus stops /cash required/.

The city centre is easily accessible from CATC. The metro station Nádraží Veleslavín can be reached by bus 119 in about 10 minutes. From here you can reach any other place in the centre of Prague within 10 minutes.

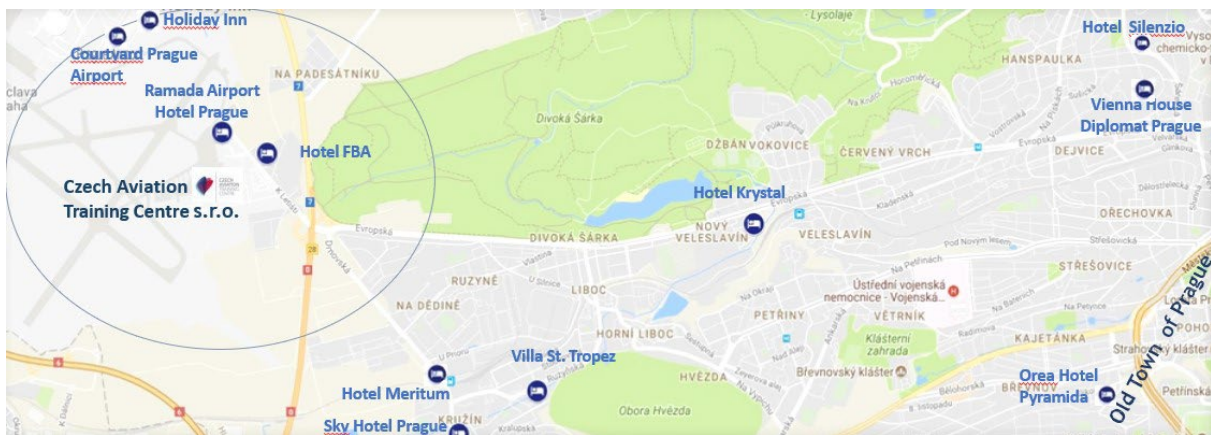
