

Cargo & Dangerous Goods Training

IATA Dangerous Goods Regulations Course

Cat. 3, Recurrent - Classroom



1. Initial Situation

A person has a valid Dangerous Goods Regulations Course certificate, the validity of which is about to expire.

2. Course Objective

The aim of this course is to refresh student's knowledge of IATA rules for Dangerous Goods, to understand the legal aspects and responsibilities of shippers, agents and airlines involved in the transport of Dangerous Goods, and how to correctly identify and classify Dangerous Goods, ensure that the goods have been properly packed, marked and labelled, fill in and check the "Shippers Declaration for Dangerous Goods", prepare Air Waybills according to IATA rules, deliver consignments containing dangerous goods to airlines - ready to send.



3. Entry Requirements

Every applicant shall provide evidence of the following:

- Good knowledge of written English,
- Valid IATA Certificate of Dangerous Goods Regulations Course - cat. 3 - Initial.

4. Course Description and Duration

The IATA Dangerous Goods Regulations Course - cat. 3 is lectured by a professional IATA Dangerous Goods instructor and the covered topics are: general philosophy, general requirements for shippers, limitations, classification, list of dangerous goods, general packing requirements, documentation, packing instructions, labelling and marking, emergency procedures, recognition of undeclared dangerous goods and provisions for passengers and crew.

Courses are carried out in Czech language (in English on request), a written exam is in English.

4.1 Theoretical Training

➤ Classroom instruction

- 48 hours of classroom instruction with a professional IATA Dangerous Goods instructor

The whole Dangerous Goods Regulations Course usually takes 6 days.
